



What we've been up to this year

Our historic year began with our Global Artist Open Call, run alongside five other festivals in the Baltic Nordic Fringe Network. We welcomed a record number of applications since the change to our open call in 2021 and engaged our brilliant community to help create this year's programme.

We Are Fringe project

While the first months of the year were focused on the artist selection and programming process, we also launched the We Are Fringe project, which was formed thanks to support from Pronto.

In the We Are Fringe project, three artist groups were chosen from the open call to participate in the project, which sees the artists receive financial support to develop their show for the festival, as well as professional mentorship. Those chosen were at three different stages of their careers with one being a local group (Lillebror), one an international exchange group (Il Milione) and one a returning Gothenburg Fringe legend (Elsa Couvreur).

Marketing campaign and rebrand

At the end of 2024, we collaborated with Kulturverkstan in a marketing project with students as they delved into the organisation's marketing strategy, core values and identity. Following this project, we adopted their suggestion for an update to the branding, keeping up with the development of the festival over recent years.

This resulted in a new look for our logo, a campaign to celebrate the 10 years of Gothenburg Fringe and design elements for the new festival website gbgfringe.com.

International representation

On the back of our successful participation in the European Festivals Fund for Emerging Artists in 2023 and 2024, we were invited to attend the European Festivals Summit in Edinburgh this April, to discuss our work with artists and promote Gothenburg as a festival city. We attended as the only festival present from Sweden. Additionally, we will be present at Fringe festivals across Europe this year in Reykjavik, Milan, Dublin, Edinburgh and Colchester, all self-funded or through additional grants to maintain partnership relations, engage in knowledge exchange and promote participation at Gothenburg Fringe in future years.



The Angel Riots, bloody and out of love Alexander Gallimore, Meeri Aro

Psychological warfare breaks out between two gay interracial ex-lovers, a Fallen Angel and a Painter from Earth. Where do the memories of their 'sin' go after death? Does God see all? And how did they fall in love to begin with? The Angel Riots, bloody and out of love, is a piece of experimental theatre exploring the spiritual and romantic purgatory gay young people feel trapped in as they come of age under religious coercion. We follow both sides of their love story, flipping back and forth between the perspective of the Angel and the Painter, both fighting to gain the audiences' trust.

The performance on 31 August is a work-in-progress showing, open to the public.



'Betty' is a bold, theatrical experience that reimagines the story of former First Lady Betty Ford—her struggle as a politician's wife, her battle with addiction, her activism, and her journey through denial and recovery.

Blending the high-energy artistry of théâtre du geste with an innovative approach to gender representation, 'Betty' challenges convention. Using non-binary casting to highlight gender issues of the 1970s, this production offers a fresh, thought-provoking production that is as visually captivating as it is emotionally resonant. Developed by the Ohlavaka Ensemble since March 2022, the production has taken shape through international residencies in Chicago, Paris, Germany, and Spain—bringing a global perspective to this uniquely powerful story.

'The Emigrants' from Gaza **Einat Weizman**

This play is an act of resistance against the cultural genocide in Gaza. It works to continue, preserve, and amplify the lost culture. It echoes the last production performed in Gaza at "Theater for Everybody" - The Emigrants. Two Palestinian actors from '48 step into the roles of their Gazan counterparts and recreate their performances. The lights, costumes, acting, and directing follow the original play from Gaza. This reenactment is interspersed with the testimonies of one of the original Gazan actors, Hossam Al-Madhoun, who recounts life under genocide until he manages to leave Gaza to Egypt six months later. The actors do not just perform — they present evidence. The audience will not just watch — they will bear witness. The performance will build a fragile, stubborn world on stage while the real world collapses outside.

Koloristen

A performance inspired by the life of the painter Åke Göransson, which was a fascinating and heartbreaking war between conditions and passion. For Göransson, painting was a necessity and could arise anywhere. During his last days, a treasure of most of his artwork was found in the kitchen sofa in Landala. He claimed that they were "just studies, not finished yet". For posterity, he is one of Sweden's most prominent painters and expressionists. What drove Göransson to continue painting through poverty, tuberculosis and mental illness?

What drives the artist to continue creating despite the worst possible conditions? This is also reflected in a parallel story - a single mother trying to survive as an actress. Koloristen is a manifesto for the strong human need to express and experience the unspoken through the means of expression of art.



Autistic Double Bill: Wave Function Collapse and stimm Vigdís Birna Grétarsdóttir and Sigrún Ósk Stefánsdóttir

Being autistic often comes with challenges in finding both identity and community. In this double bill two autistic dancers/choreographers cross paths on their ways to self discovery/knowledge/acceptance/love and common joy. Wave Function Collapse: The name comes from the world of quantum physics, and refers to how observation causes light to collapse into either a wave or particle form when observed. This piece is soft and abstract but it is also very exact. stimm: In spring of 2024 I got together with 7 other autistic people to make a performance, it was my final work towards a BA-degree in dance. The performance was born out of a need for role models and resources around autism in

the performing arts. It was an attempt to be that role model myself and to create new resources while giving space to the ones we already carry in our bodies.





Dice Theater Karl Johansgatan 62

Welcome to Dice Theater, a stage for musical theater and improvisation in the center of Gothenburg.

We offer international collaborations, acting, dance and singing classes and shows several times a week. Performers need a stage, but also an audience. Here at Dice Theater we are both. So roll your dice, have fun with us!.



Folkets Hus Hammarkullen Hammarkulletorget 62B

Folkets Hus Hammarkullen is an inclusive and open meeting place for democracy, community, culture, innovation and education.

Folkets Hus is just a 14-minute tram ride from the city centre and will be a Fringe venue for the first time, hosting two performances of 'The Emigrants' from Gaza, emulating the last play performed in Gaza at Theater for Everybody.



Kvartersscenen 2Lång Andra Långgatan 30

One of Gothenburg's best stages for entertainment and culture. Kvarterscenen ZLång is a creative meeting place which offers theatre, entertainment, and theatre courses. BörsenGustaf Adolfs Torg 5

Börsen ("The Bourse") is the official representative building of the City of Gothenburg and Sweden's most lavish building when it was once built for the city's merchants.

The city council holds its meetings here. The building was inaugurated in 1849 as a commercial or mercantile exchange and festivities building. Börsen and Gustaf Adolfs torg will play host to our opening evening activities.



Frölunda Kulturhus Valthornsgatan 13

Frölunda Kulturhus is full of life—a vibrant cultural hub filled with inspiration, creativity, and community! Here you can experience performing arts, film, art exhibitions, hands-on activities, and exciting programmes for all ages.
